Richard Werbner takes readers on a journey through contemporary charismatic wisdom divination in southern Africa. Beginning with the silent language of the divinatory lots, Werbner deciphers the everyday, metaphorical, and poetic language that is used to reveal their meaning. Through Werbner's skillful interpretations of the language of divination, a picture of Tswana moral imagination is revealed. Concerns about dignity and personal illumination, witchcraft, pollution, the anger of dead ancestors, as well as the nature of life, truth, cosmic harmony, being, and becoming emerge in this charged African setting.

**Richard Werbner** is Professor Emeritus in African Anthropology at the University of Manchester. He is author of *Reasonable Radicals* and *Citizenship in Botswana* (IUP).
